Sentimental Disco

CORE goes Pop! The band's fourth album (following „away“/2003, „halfplugged“/2005 and „perfect summer“/2006) proves that CORE is not at all tired of experimenting and developing. CORE even defines evolution as the only way to keep it real.

Frontman Chris Harras: „Our lives change continuously. Therefore it would be weird if our music always stayed the same. Maybe it's because of the phase of our lives or maybe because of our age - with this album we didn't look for the real heavy stuff within our music. We evolve as human beings, so why freeze in an artistic pose?“

Bass player Harry Jilg: „There has been a period after our last record, *Perfect Summer*, when we thought that we were running on empty. Our creative output came to a hold. But then we dared to head in a new direction and the engine got going again ...“

Drummer Sascha Bém: „*Sentimental Disco* feels a little bit like getting together with a friend that you haven't met for three years. You realize that he has gone through quite a bit and that he is not the person he used to be – but he still knows how to party.“

History & Facts

Since the band's start in 2002 CORE has been performing in Europe and in the US, including two shows at the world famous „Viper Room“ in Hollywood.

CORE songs have been featured in MTV's shows „Viva La Bam“ and „Meet The Barkers“. The song „The Angle“ is part of the soundtrack of the videogame „Smackdown vs. Raw“ (Playstation and X-Box) which won the band fans all over the world. The same song has also been used in a TV car commercial for BMW.

Since 2006 CORE releases on its own label, Corecosmos Recordings.

Going way back in time: Harras, Jilg and Bém used to be the CORE-trio of the four piece band Paradise Now! in the late nineties – which undoubtedly was one of the very few acts internationally opening both for U2 as well as The Rolling Stones.
